RHINO RANGER COMPETITION

Who can apply?

The competition is open to Vietnamese youth from the participating schools, and who must fit into one of the two categories:

- Junior: Aged 14 and younger on 1 July 2019.
- Senior: Aged 15 years and older on 1 July 2019.

Deadline

The deadline for competition entries is 15 January 2019.

How to Apply

Application is through the website www.wildrhino.org. Find the 'Enter Here' button. Make sure you read all the information, including the supporting documents. You will need to think of innovative and practical ideas that you will use to educate your friends and family on ways to end the demand for rhino horn.

Junior Competition

- Format of entry: Ask your teacher for the Wild Rhino Competition frame and draw a picture of a rhino or write a poem inside the frame. Take a photo of the drawing or poem and upload it via the junior entry form on the website. For a better quality entry, ask your teacher to scan it and upload it to the website for you.

Senior Competition

- Format of entry: Write an essay of 500 words on "Innovative and practical things that I can do to educate my friends and family on how to end the demand for rhino horn". Upload your essay to the website.
- Winners of the Senior competition must agree to act as Wild Rhino Youth Ambassadors for at least 2 years and to participate in associated activities in Vietnam.

Entrants will need:

- To give their contact details (including date of birth)
- To submit the entry as per their category

Each entrant may only submit one entry. All entries will be uploaded via the website so there will be no return of entries.

By submitting an entry, applicants absolutely assign with full title guarantee all and any intellectual property rights throughout the world in the competition work to Wilderness Foundation Africa and their partners without restriction.

The Prize

Junior Competition:

- The final junior winners will receive a goody bag

Senior Competition:

- The final winners will win a trip to South Africa in July 2019, which includes a 5 day wilderness trail and a 1 day workshop thereafter. They will be appointed as Wild Rhino Youth Ambassadors and become a member of the Wild Rhino Alumni.

There is no cash substitute to the prize.

The expedition is fully funded. Applicants will however be responsible for their own travel to and from the airport in Vietnam before and after the trail. During the trail all travel, activities, accommodation as well as food and drink will be provided.

The trail will run during July 2019.

Restrictions for Senior Competition:

Applicants cannot participate if any of the following apply:

- They do not have a valid passport on 1 March 2019
- They are under the age of 15 on 1 July 2019
- They are not a registered scholar of one of the participating schools

Applicants will also need to have access to the internet in order to apply online.

All applications must be written and submitted in English.

How will the competition be judged?

- There will be a judging panel consisting of four individuals
- Selection Process: Judges will choose the top entrants
- Judges decision is final

Criteria for judging entries will be based on the following:

- **Innovative:** how the entrant has thought 'outside the box' to form a solution from scratch or based on existing schemes
- **Practical and feasible:** Demonstrate how practical considerations have been taken into account and thought through
- **High impact:** how much the idea(s) will help reduce the demand for rhino horn
- **Knowledge:** level of background knowledge of the situation in South Africa
- **Presentation:** level of creative competence; how ideas are presented through the essay/poem/drawing
- **Passion:** how has the entrant communicated their passion for conservation and how will the journey help them to build on this when they return

Notification of winners

The final winners will be announced on 28 February 2019. The prize is received when the trail (the prize) takes place in July 2019.

Announcement of winners

After the winners have been notified there will be an announcement of their names, where they are from, and ages (no other personal information will be revealed in the announcement). The announcement will be made to the principals of the participating schools, in a press release and on the competition Facebook page.

Announcement will take place by the end of February 2019 (but only after the winners have been notified).

Winners may be called upon to engage in post promotion work which may consist of (but not limited to) media interviews.

Definitions

“Competition work” means any material submitted as an entry for this competition, whether it is an essay, a poem or a drawing.

Assignment of Intellectual Property

Competition work submitted must be your own original and unpublished work.

By submitting an entry you confirm that your competition work is your original, unpublished work, that you own all intellectual property rights in it and that no other person has any right, title or interest in or to it or is entitled to any payment for the use of any intellectual property rights in it.

Wilderness Foundation Africa and their partners reserve the right (in its sole discretion) to disqualify any entry if found to be: plagiarized; fraudulent; to infringe others’ rights; incomplete; damaged; obscene; vulgar; offensive; or otherwise unsuitable.

By submitting an entry, you hereby absolutely assign with full title guarantee all and any intellectual property rights throughout the world in the competition work to the Wilderness Foundation and their partners without restriction.

You also irrevocably waive all moral rights under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 (and all similar rights in other jurisdictions) which you have or will have, performers’ rights and similar rights in respect of your competition work in favour of Wilderness Foundation Africa and their partners.

By doing so you agree that you will not grant any third party rights in or to the competition work and confirm and represent that you have full authority to assign all such rights to Wilderness Foundation Africa and their partners.
